The Commission calls for a climate neutral Europe by 2050

Commissioner for Climate Action and Energy, Miguel Arias Cañete said: "The EU has already started the modernisation and transformation towards (1) a climate neutral economy. And today, we are stepping up our efforts as we propose a strategy for Europe to become the world's first major economy to go climate neutral by 2050. Going climate neutral is necessary, possible and in Europe's **interest** (2). It is necessary to meet the long-term temperature goals of the Paris Agreement. It is **possible** (3) with current technologies and those close to deployment. And it is in Europe's interest to stop spending on fossil fuel imports and invest in meaningful improvements to the daily lives of all Europeans. No European, no region should be left behind. The EU will support those more impacted by this transition so that everyone's ready to adapt to the new requirements of a climate neutral economy."

The **road** (4) to a climate neutral economy would require joint action in seven strategic areas: energy efficiency; deployment of renewables; clean, safe and connected mobility; competitive industry and circular economy; infrastructure and interconnections; bio-economy and natural carbon sinks; carbon capture and storage to address remaining emissions. Pursuing all **these** (5) strategic priorities would contribute to making our vision a reality.

Tectonic Plates, Volcanoes and Earthquakes

In the 1960s, scientists discovered that the Earth's crust consists of large, separate pieces called "tectonic plates". There are seven or eight very large plates and several smaller ones. The tectonic plates of the Earth are always moving. Over millions of years the continents have changed their position. If you look at a map of the world, you can see how Africa and South America were joined together in the past. Today, America is moving slowly away from Europe and Africa, but only a few centimetres every year.

Dramatic geological events often happen in the areas where different tectonic plates meet. Mountains (like the Hilmayas and the Andes) were formed during a collision of plates.

Sometimes one plate is forced under another plate. This type of movement can create earthquakes, tsunamis and volcanoes.
